Tips for requesting professional development support from your organization to participate in Illuminate Your Leadership

- 1. **Reach out to your supervisor** to let them know that you've identified a coaching program that you'd really like to participate in and would like to seek full or partial funding from the organization to support you. Share the high-level information about the program included on the following page.
- 2. **Talk about the benefits of your participation.** What organizational goals are you trying to achieve right now, and how will your participation improve your ability to help your organization achieve those goals?
- 3. Connect your participation to your own personal goals. If you and your manager have already identified areas for your development, explain how this program connects to those areas you're focused on.
- 4. Be clear that you will bring your learnings back to your team and the organization, so this program will benefit everyone not only you.
- 5. See if your supervisor or HR department has any questions, and please don't hesitate to reach out to us if we can help answer those for you!
